Editorial Policy and Guidelines

The CELIS Country Report is an initiative of the CELIS Institute ('Publisher'). The project aims to provide well-informed, open access analysis on foreign investment regulation, with a particular focus on investment screening in various jurisdictions. We publish concise overviews of national foreign investment screening regimes, called CELIS Country Notes, more detailed analysis on specific issues relating to these regimes, called CELIS Issue Notes, and comprehensive, in-depth reports, called CELIS Country Reports.

By submitting a contribution, the Contributor agrees to comply with the current version of these Guidelines. The Publisher may revise the Guidelines at any time. The most recent version will be published on the CELIS Institute website.

Editorial Standards and Submission Process

Submissions shall be clear, precise, original and analytically rigorous. Contributors shall adhere to the CELIS Standard Questionnaire for formatting, citations, and structure. The CELIS Editorial Team reserves the right to edit, request revisions, or decline submissions that do not meet these standards. Submissions undergo internal editorial review. Substantial edits will be discussed with the Contributor.

Copyright and Licensing

By submitting a contribution, the Contributor grants the Publisher a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, irrevocable licence to publish, reproduce, distribute, and publicly display the contribution in any format and to edit or adapt it for formatting or consistency purposes. The Contributor retains copyright.

If third-party material is included, the Contributor must obtain and document prior written permission. If the work was previously published, this must be disclosed.

Warranties and Indemnification

By submitting a contribution, the Contributor warrants that the submitted work is original, does not infringe third-party rights, and is free from unlawful or defamatory content. The Contributor confirms they have obtained all necessary permissions and approvals prior to submission and will indemnify and hold harmless the Publisher from any legal claims related to the submission.



Rights and Attribution

Contributors retain the right to reuse their work, including sharing on personal or institutional platforms, provided they cite CELIS as the original publisher. Third-party republication requires permission. The Publisher may cross-post content on affiliated platforms.

Editorial Independence and Content Responsibility

All submissions must be fact-based, neutral, and free from conflicts of interest. If the Contributor has been involved in a matter discussed, this must be disclosed. The Publisher reserves the right to decline or remove submissions that fail to meet these standards.

Remuneration and Affiliation

Contributions are voluntary and unpaid. Submission does not create an employment relationship or entitlement to compensation. Access to internal CELIS resources may be granted as needed for the preparation of contributions. The name 'CELIS', including derivatives and logos, is the property of the Publisher. Contributors may identify themselves as 'CELIS Country Reporters' for non-commercial purposes, as long as the use does not harm the CELIS Institute's interests.

Governing Law and Disputes

These Guidelines are governed by the laws of Germany. Any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Berlin, Germany. Parties shall first attempt to resolve any disagreements in good faith.
